Whites

2014 CHARDONNAY, Sand Point, Lodi Valley, California 6.00

Features fresh aromas of tropical fruit and ripe apple. Layers of sweet apple, vanilla and fresh pineapple are revealed on the palate, which are balanced by oak notes. With a creamy texture supported by fresh acidity, it is a luscious wine with a long, clean finish.

CHARDONNEL, Cold Country, Tisch Mills, Wisconsin 7.00

Chardonel is made from the Chardonel grape, which is a cross between Chardonnay and Seyval Blanc. This wonderful offering was crafted in the exact methodology as Chardonnay and it is following nicely in its parent's footsteps. It is a dry white wine of complex tones of fruit, smoke and oak, with a delightfully spicy finish.

2016 SAUVANGOIN BLANC, Bolder Bond, New Zealand 7.50

This sophisticated white wine offers a fresh peach, tangerine, apricot fresh fruit focus on a fleshy texture mingling the acidity with a soft touch. The roots of the vineyard fall below sea level (one off only 5 in the world) and the salinity adds an attractive note to the minerality of the wine. 89 Wine Spectator

2015 PINOT GRIGIO, Tenuta Alpina, Italy 7.50

Color is a straw yellow with light amber colored tinges. Aromas are fruity and floral, banana, pineapple and wisteria flowers. The finish is persistent with excellent body and correct balance.

SUMMER MORNINGS, Cold Country, Tisch Mills, Wisconsin 7.00

Summer Mornings is a blend of cold climate grapes. It is a semi-sweet wine with notes of peach, pear and grapefruit. It has a slightly darker straw color.

2015 SPATLESE – Karl Josef Piesporter, Germany 6.00

This Riesling displays aromas and flavors of candied apples and pears. Lush, rich and expressive with an intense fruit and a long flavorful finish. Medium bodied.

ROCK LEDGEND, Cold Country, Tisch Mills, Wisconsin 7.50

(Carbonated) a rose' blend of Cold Country Vines & Wines estate grown grapes. This carbonated wine is made in the Muscato style and has a fragrance of strawberry, pineapple, and orange peel.

2013 CABERNET, Estampa, Chile

6.00

Dense cassis and berry aromas aren't nuanced or complex. Overall rich and balanced. Plum, berry, cassis and cherry flavors and tasty and easy to like. 90 points Wine Enthusiast

MERLOT, Cold Country, Tisch Mills, WI

8.00

This selection has soft tannins and has a black cherry and berry nose with hints of orange peel and plum.

2016 PINOT NOIR, Sand Point, Lodi Valley, California

6.00

An immediately approachable wine, offering aromas and flavors of dense ripe strawberry and cherry cola. With French and American Oak aging, there is a hint of soft spice that melds into the opening notes, creating a smooth and balanced wine that is easy to enjoy.

2013 MALBEC, Estampa, Chile

6.00

Deep ruby purple in color with a black fruit, green bell pepper nose and taste. Dry with medium body and plum fruit flavor. Notes of black pepper and a hint of earth. Soft tannins. 90 pt Wine Enthusiast

8.00

50% Merlot, 48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Cabernet Franc. 91 points Wine Spectator

2015 Meritage Alexander Valley Sonoma, Fidelity, California

7.50

88% Merlot with a balancing of 12% Cabernet Sauvignon. This is a soft gentle wine, rich and satisfying. 88 points Editors Choice Wine Enthusiast
